Dear Membership:

At the Annual Membership Meeting of the Law Enforcement Benevolent Fund of Northern Virginia held on November 3, 2021, the attending members voted to increase the payout benefit from its current value of \$20,000 to \$25,000. This change is in accordance with the Bylaws of the Fund, specifically Article IV, Section 1, which can be viewed at www.lawenforcementfund.org. This benefit increase will increase dues from \$2.00 per paycheck to \$2.50 per paycheck for all members. The increased payout benefit and dues increase are effective January 1, 2022.

The last increase to the benefit and dues took place in 2012. The Fund strives to maintain an affordable benefit but felt with inflation, the \$25,000 payout would be more beneficial in a time of need while maintaining a minimal cost to members. At the new rate, a member would pay only \$1625 over a 25-year career to ensure a \$25,000 benefit is available to their beneficiary within 24 hours of their passing.

Over the past 22 years, the Fund has provided these benefits to 73 families, totaling over \$1.3 million. We intend to continue to be available to provide this vital assistance as needed.
